1720 Nationals Notice to Competitors

Explanation of application of Blue flag signal in regards to Appendix UF in the umpired fleet racing for 1720 Nationals:

The Blue flag applies when the umpires do not have the facts to make a decision on the water.

Example:

If the umpires did not see the incident in question.

A competitor must request a decision from an umpire during the race or as soon as possible after finishing that race.

The umpire will signal a decision that the competitor is entitled to a hearing by displaying a blue flag and making a loud sound signal.

The related hearing will then be scheduled as per Appendix UF.
