

BALTIMORE SAILING CLUB DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURE

Unacceptable Behaviour



Verbal warning to Sailor from Level Instructor and reported to Senior Instructor



Senior Instructor to speak to Sailor and report to Junior Organiser/Junior Liaison Officer/Children's Officer



Sailor removed from activity, parent contacted and sailor to leave course for the remainder of that day



Disciplinary Meeting with Sailor, Parent, Senior Instructor, Children's Officer and one other Club Committee member. Action to be decided



If any further unacceptable behaviour occurs, Sailor will be removed from the Sailing Course and will not be awarded IS Level. Future acceptance of Sailor on a BSC sailing course may be affected

(Unacceptable Behaviour includes: Bullying at any level; dangerous behaviour; disrespectful behaviour to fellow sailors, instructors, course organisers; club employees, Committee members and parents; Unacceptable language.)
